All papers opposing a motion so noticed shall be filed with the court and a copy served on each party at least nine court days, and all reply papers at least five court days before the hearing. The court, or a judge thereof, may prescribe a shorter time.

The California Code of Civil Procedure now requires “[a]ny documents or category of documents produced in response to a demand for inspection, copying, testing, or sampling shall be identified with the specific request number to which the documents respond.” Cal. Civ. Pro. § 2031.280(a). This is a major departure from the prior rule.

The Federal Rules of Civil Procedure (eff. Dec. 1, 2019) govern civil proceedings in the United States district courts. Their purpose is “to secure the just, speedy, and inexpensive determination of every action and proceeding.” Fed. R. Civ. P. 1.

Due to the conflict between the Code of Civil Procedure and the Rules of Court, best practice is to use the shorter time limit] Serve Defendant Added via Amended Complaint – 30 days after adding. [Source: CRC 3.110 (b)] Proof of Service of Summons and Complaint (proving to Court that you served Defendant) – 60 days after filing complaint.
